HOW TO UPLOAD



1. Scan QR Code to access the link to our shared drive
2. Select the folder for the Program that you volunteered for
3. Select the Folder of the date that you volunteered
4. Create a New Folder named, "Game Time, Team vs Team, Your Name/ Group"
Ex: "9AM Padres vs Pirates John Doe Plymouth Varsity Baseball"
5. Upload your Pictures!
