




BEING OUR VOICE

Before Gameday

Our Executive Director will create a script and email it to you at least one day before your shift. Please review all the highlights and change the wording to what you feel most comfortable with. Following the script will accomplish everything we are hoping for. You will also have an Event Coordinator nearby the entire time for assistance if you need it.

Pre-Game Prep at Field

Please plan to arrive at least 20 minutes before game start time. We will have the announcer table set up. Our staff will set up the sound system and microphones. The Coaches will provide you their rosters and you'll have an opportunity to try out pronunciations and ensure you are all on the same page.

Time to Play Ball!

While you will have your own voice on the mic, the order of operations generally are:

- Starting Lineups for each team
- Introducing National Anthem (either recording or live)
- Instructing the crowd its time to “play ball!”
- Introduce players as they come up to bat
- Follow script in terms of plugins
- Inform players when its time to switch sides
- Inform everyone when the last batter crosses home plate and ask the crowd for final a round of applause for our MLP All-Stars
